Wind Turbine Approved

The Board of Education has taken another step forward in providing clean energy to Northwest Regional Middle and High Schools. At its October 13, 2010 meeting, the Board of Education approved the construction of an on-site wind turbine.

The turbine is expected to produce 500,000 kilowatts of electricity per year.

The structure will stand 199' tall on the hill behind the field hockey field. It will be assembled on site and is scheduled to be completed by 12/31/12.

The wind turbine, together with the solar panels, is projected to produce between one-half and two-thirds of the district's power.

This will reduce our exposure to rising electricity costs which will ultimately free up resources for educational purposes.
