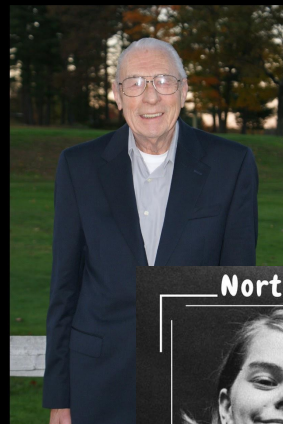


World War II - Life Under Nazi Rule

Mr. Ted Veling of Norwalk, CT, was 9 years old when the Nazi German Army invaded his country. As World War II intensified, the restrictions imposed by the Nazis on freedoms increased dramatically. Mr. Veling made survival decisions daily, and he chose not to be a bystander. With the other boys in his neighborhood and his family, Mr. Veling helped protect all the citizens on his block and rescued 42 Jewish people. Because of Mr. Veling and his community's heroic efforts, all 42 survived the Holocaust. His story revolves around the idea of working together in order to insure the survival of all. Mr. Veling has dedicated his life to being a good person, citizen, and to helping others throughout his life in our community.
