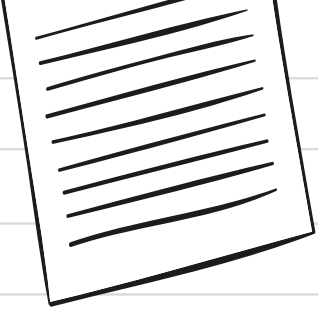


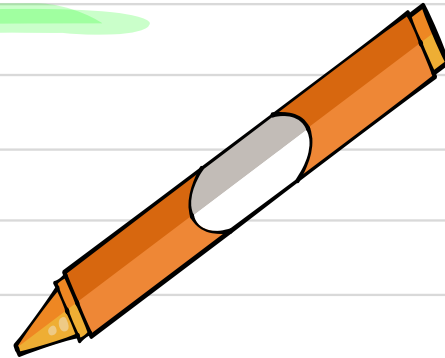

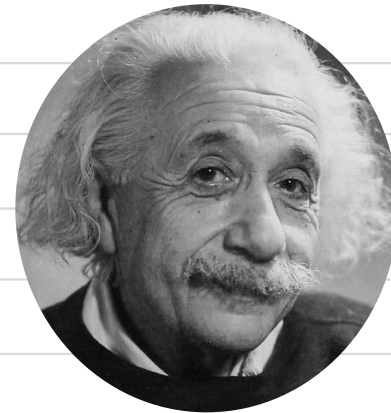


CONTACT THE TEACHER DIRECTLY




Using the Agenda

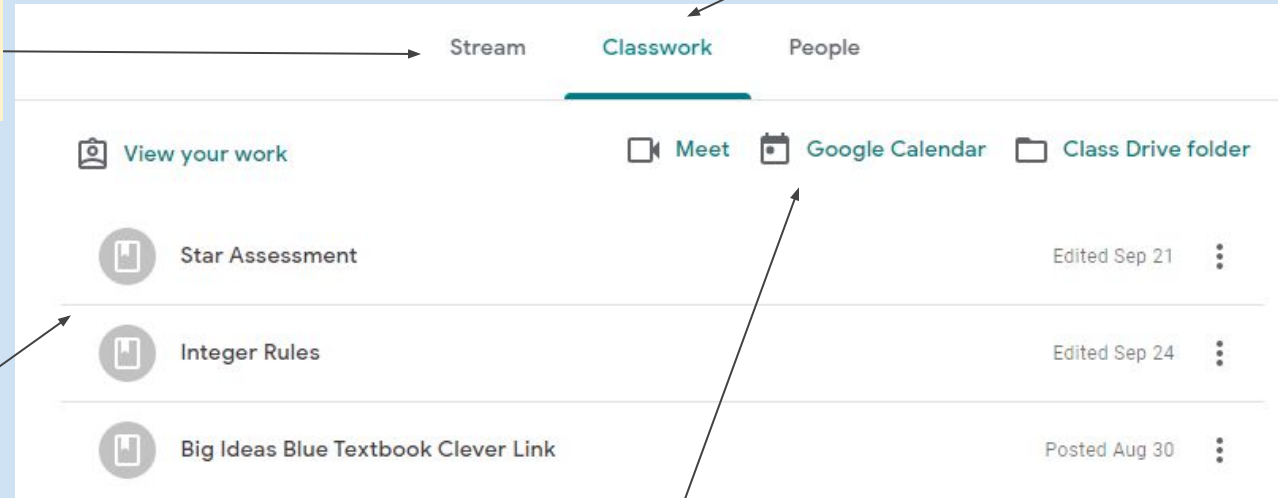

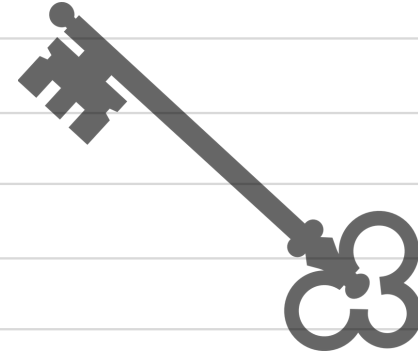
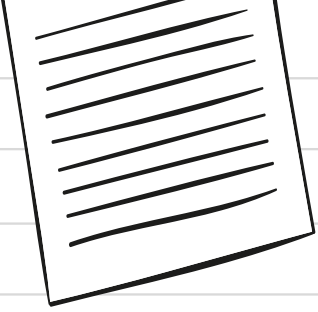
Some teachers organize work in topics by theme or by week

The calendar shows due dates of all digital assignments.

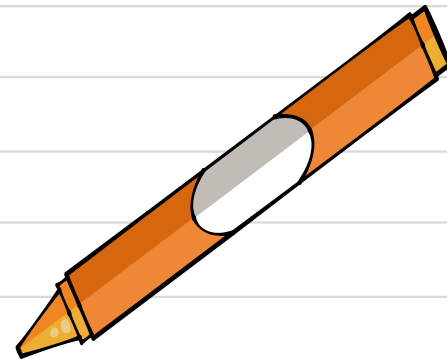


Parent Conferences

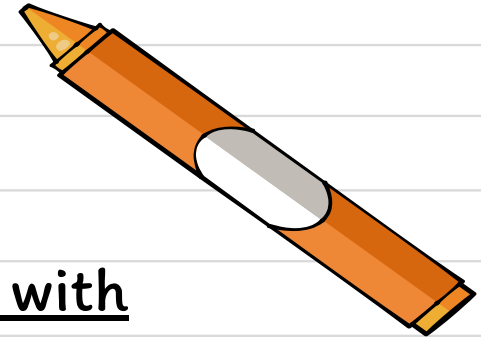
How You Can Help Your Child This Year



- Have your child set their intention for the day
- Encourage your child to limit distractions during homework time including video games and television
- Make sure your child has a quiet area to work that is conducive to learning
- Check in with your child periodically

What to do if Your Child is Absent

- Call the MS office and/or school nurse
- Students should rest and get better
- When feeling better, students should check with teachers the day they return to find out what they missed
- Check Google Classroom for any updated notes or assignments
- Check in with your teachers in person or through email
- Students should plan to access each teacher on the next academic help day to make up work, clarify concepts, and to make up tests

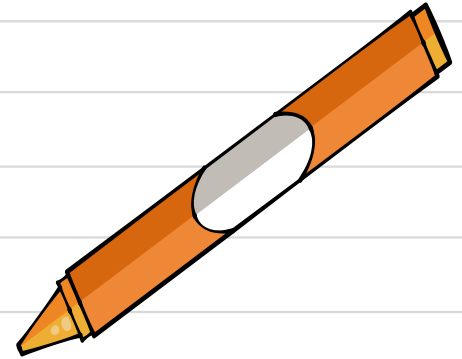
