Mr. Chichester provided updates on High School reform with comparison of graduation requirements; questions followed on differences between current requirements, and discussion and concerns followed on mandates and costs. Mr. Chichester provided information pertaining to an extended learning opportunity to earn high school credit for the FIRST Robotics Team with portfolio requirements.
